## RE: ORDER CALLING A TRUSTEE ELECTION

BE IT ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE DENISON INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT:

- 1. That an election be held in Ward 1, Ward 2, Ward 4, and Ward 7 in said School District on May 3, 2025, for the purpose of electing to the Board of Trustees of said School District members to fill Position No. 3, Ward 2, Position No. 4, Ward 4, Position 5, Ward 1, and Position 6, Ward 7.
- 2. That all requests by candidates to have their names placed on the ballot for the above-mentioned election shall be in writing and signed by the candidate. The application shall be filed with the Secretary of the School Board of Trustees at the School Administration Office not later than 78 days prior to the date of said election (Friday, February 14, 2025). All candidates shall file with said application the loyalty affidavit required (Sec. 141.031, Election Code).
  - 3. That said election for all Wards shall be held at the following place:

Grayson County Sub-Courthouse, 101 W. Woodard, Denison, Texas

- 4. Grayson County Election Administration shall be in charge of procedures governing said election.
- 5. That it is hereby ordered that early voting shall begin on April 22, 2025, and continue through April 25, 2025, at the Grayson County Sub-Courthouse, 101 W. Woodard, Denison, Texas between the hours of 8:00 o'clock a.m. and 5:00 o'clock p.m., Monday through Friday. In addition, on April 28, 2025 and April 29, 2025, the hours of early voting shall be 7:00 am to 7:00 pm, and to be conducted otherwise pursuant to the requirement of the Texas Election Code. On May 3, 2025 election hours will be from 7:00 am to 7:00 pm.
- 6. The ballots shall be translated into Spanish, eliminating the need to appoint an interpreter for said election.
- 7. The method of voting in said election shall be by the "Electronic Scanner" use. In all respects, the election shall be conducted in accordance with the Code. Pursuant to the federal Help America Vote Act ("HAVA") and the Code, at each polling place there shall be at least one voting system that is equipped for disabled individuals, and each such voting system shall be a system that has been certified by the Texas Secretary of State as compliant with HAVA and the Code.
