

GRAYSON COUNTY JUVENILE BOARD MINUTES

A meeting of the Juvenile Board of Grayson County was held on Tuesday February 10, 2026 at 12:03 pm in the conference room located at 200 S. Crockett, Sherman, TX 75090.

I. Quorum was present: Judge Dunn, Judge Phillips, Judge Fallon, Judge Dawsey, Judge Gary, Suzette Smith, LaTonya Moore, Trevor Timpanaro, and Alan Brown were present.

II. Judge Phillips moves to adopt minutes as presented. Judge Gary 2nd. All in favor.

III. Action Items:

- a. Present and discuss population numbers for pre and post facilities-JJAEP- and related funding: Post started the day with 48 with 1 release scheduled. Detention has 20 residents, and JJAEP has 3 students.
- b. Discuss and take possible action on annual Performance and Management Review for JJAEP: Mr. Timpanaro has been contacting schools directly. All current JJAEP students are mandatory. Two students who were admitted in November have gone to homeschool.
- c. Discuss and take possible action on an update on Monarch request for variance: Variance has been submitted. Was originally submitted on wrong form, but has been resubmitted correctly. No action needed.
- d. Discuss HB16 progress: no updates at this time
- e. Interim Director Updates: discussion
- f.
