Campaign Sign Guidelines Grayson County Effective September 22, 2015

Pursuant to H.B. 259 and Texas Election Code 61.003, an entity that owns a public building may enact reasonable regulations concerning the time, place and manner of electioneering.

The guidelines for the placement of campaign signs on the Grayson County Courthouse lawn are as follows:

- Signs will be allowed in the northeast (Houston/Travis St. corner) and southeast quadrants (Lamar/Travis St. corner) only.
- Signs must be placed within four feet of the sidewalk.
- Signs will be limited to one per candidate per quadrant.
- Signs may be posted no earlier than the first day of Early Voting and must be removed no later than the day after Election Day.
- Signs may not be larger than 18x24 inches.
